Why spay/neuter?

- ❑ Altered rabbits are healthier, live longer and make better companions than unaltered rabbits
- ❑ Avoidance of obnoxious behavior
- ❑ Diminish the problem of overpopulation of rabbits
- ❑ Can safely have a friend to play with

When to spay/neuter?

- ❑ Female: 6 months of age 
- ❑ Male: 4 months of age
- ❑ Opposite-gender rabbits will have to be housed separately until both are fixed
